

Frequently Asked Questions

Where can I quietly console my child?

The room attached to the nursery is provided with glider chairs to help console your child.

Where can I privately feed my child?

The women's bathroom located in the west hall has a couch for a quiet and private feeding time.

Do the volunteers change diapers?

No, we will page the parent to come and change a wet or dirty diaper.

How can I be a nursery volunteer?

We are grateful for each volunteer we have. You can volunteer if you are a member of Haven, pass a screening check for working with children or youth (found in the church office) and attend nursery training. If you meet these requirements, please sign up on the Nursery Communication Sheet located in the Information Center in the back of church.

When is nursery training provided?

We offer a nursery training/refresher course every six months. Watch the News and Notes for training announcements.

What are the age requirements for the children in the nursery?

We welcome children from newborn to four years in age. There are other ministry options available to children ages three and up. Three's for three-year olds and Children In Worship for older children are dismissed during the offering.

What is the well-child policy?

No child may be in the nursery if he/she has had any symptoms of illness in the last 48 hours. Illness symptoms:

- Runny Nose
- Fever
- Cough
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Pink-Eye
- Rash (excluding diaper)

What is your emergency procedure?

In case of tornado, the children will be taken to the men's bathroom across the hall from the nursery.

In case of fire we will use the windows or doorways if accessible.

What are the nursery volunteer requirements?

They must arrive 20 minutes prior to the service. The volunteer with an "*" next to their name is the head volunteer for that service.

What if I cannot help for the service I am scheduled?

Adults must trade with adults and youth with youth volunteers. Please notify the church office of the change.

What if a child is injured in nursery?

The head volunteer for that service must fill out an accident report form. The forms can be found in the blue binder in the nursery.
